Providing 4-year scholarships to outstanding seniors in the Katy Independent School District active in the FFA and Agriculture Science Program. The L. D. Robinson Scholarship Fund was established in 1970 to honor Mr. L.D. Robinson, the 1943 founder of the Katy I.S.D. FFA Livestock Show & Rodeo, Ag Science Farm and agriculture science program. The scholarship was established by former students with the support of the Katy I.S.D. Administration, J. A. Marshall, Director of the Texas Education Agency, and the Katy Community.

THE SCHOLARSHIP IS OPEN TO THE DEGREE PLAN AND COLLEGE OF YOUR CHOICE

I. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

A. THE APPLICANT MUST COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING:

1. Successfully completed three or more years in the FFA/agriculture science program.
2. Completed their junior and senior years in Katy I.S.D.
3. Be a member in good standing in one of the FFA chapters in Katy I.S.D.
4. Have a four year academic average of 2.5 or better, a "B" average or better in agriculture science courses, and completed college entrance exams and requirements.
5. Satisfactorily demonstrated the characteristics of citizenship, leadership, academic achievement, and involved in school and community service and activities.

B. APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

1. The scholarship application will be completed properly and in its entirety.
2. A wallet sized photo (2 ½ "x 3 ½") head/shoulder pose in official dress.
2. Official high school transcript sealed within an envelope.
3. THREE letters of recommendation from responsible community, school, or church professionals. (Letters from family or relatives are not permissible)
4. Personal letter from the applicant. Tell us something about yourself that you would like us to know and/or why you are applying for the scholarship.

C. THE RECIPIENT MUST:

1. Submit an official class schedule of work in progress each collegiate semester.
2. Maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average on a four-point system on all college courses.
3. Provide grade reports (official transcript) at the end of each semester to the scholarship board treasurer before the next check will be issued for the new semester.
4. Student must remain free of disciplinary problems and exemplify good moral behavior.
5. Furnish other scholastic information upon request.
